Romans 13:11-14

1. Reflect on your parents or other influential authorities of your childhood. How do they still affect you today?
2. Why is a way of life inherited from our forefathers a futile way (1 Peter 1:17-18)?
3. Is it wrong to have a feeling of patriotism or family pride?
4. What is it about the “time” that we need to know and *how* is it that we “know the time”?
5. If the dawning of daylight is coming, then what part of day are we living in?
6. How does knowing the time change the way we live? Being specific, are there things that become less important? More important?
7. Read 1 Corinthians 7:29a and linger over it for a moment – continue reading through 7:32a. Does this discussion shed light on what Paul says here?
8. How does gratifying desires of the flesh clash with a Christian worldview?
9. Will you think any differently about the “big” and “small” details/activities of your life?
