John 6:22-33

1. What is the weirdest edible you have ever purposely ingested? Why did you eat it? Were you craving it?
2. Have you ever done anything you consider to be wild and crazy? Was there craving behind or connected to that act?
3. How do you imagine and how would you describe the scene in verses 22-24?
4. Verse 23 says “near the place where they ate the bread *after the Lord had given thanks*”. To whom was thanks given? Why do you think John included the phrase about giving thanks?
5. Does Jesus answer the question in verse 25? To what is he replying in verse 26? How does this reply give insight into their work in verses 22-24?
6. What does it look like when we are doing the work of God?
7. If we seek God’s gifts without knowing and fearing him, will we always get what crave? Will we be satisfied?
8. If we seek God through Jesus will we get what we crave (Matthew 5:6, 1 Peter 3:18)?
9. Can you identify tendencies, areas, desires that you seek without fearing God, thanking God or while disregarding him?
