5. What is causing this sharp argument in verse 52? Why?
6. Why is this a hard saying – v60?
7. What is causing even disciples to be offended?
8. What does it look like if we are eating the flesh of Jesus and drinking his blood?
9. What other kinds of sayings of Jesus are hard and offensive? What is the danger of disregarding the hard and offensive things?
