2. Have you heard of the “slippery slope”?
3. Is Paul making a slippery slope argument in verses 1-34?
4. What is the initial error Paul is addressing?
5. What caused those who erred to make the initial error? (Verses 15, 23-28 might help answer)
6. How do you think the initial error might lead to the error in V29?
7. Do you think Paul is making a crazy leap (jumping conclusions or making a sensationalized, dramatic claim about the ultimate end of a slippery slope) in V32?
8. What is the connection, if there is one, between the initial error and the claim Paul is making about its end in V32?
9. Is there any way to logically want to care about other humans if God is not central, all-powerful, righteous and holy?
10. What is the bad company to which Paul refers in V33?
11. In what ways does this company ruin good, proper, moral way of living and interacting with others?
12. Should a proper resurrection doctrine be such a big deal to Paul?
