- 8. Considering the factors of 55-57 and the ideas of national heritage from earlier verses, why might there have been a conversation over whether this man, Jesus, would come to the feast?
- 9. Does God care if America or any other nation exists past tonight?
- 10. Is the gospel American in any way? Connected to race in any way?
- 11. Is there any part of being an American or any other facet of your life, ethnicity, heritage that is crowding out Christ and the gospel?
