- 6. Can a person practice the attributes listed in verses 12-13 and not have love overlaid on them?
- 7. Is there any value in practicing those things without love?
- 8. Does love overlook error and sin?
- 9. How does love bind together in perfect harmony?
- 10. Looking through verses 15-17, do you see the attributes from the prior verses playing out with love over them? If so, list the ways.
- 11. Can we start to do any of these more purposely for each other?
