5. How does telling them of Paul's activities accomplish this purpose?
6. Notice the describing words for Tychicus and Onesimus. Do you think there is any significance to the way Tychicus is described (titled) as opposed to Onesimus and others?
7. Help us understand how praying on behalf of others could be a hard struggle. V 12- 13
8. Describe how you might tell a preacher to fulfill his ministry.
9. Why do you think Paul commands the church to say this to Archippus?
10. Is there a difference between work received to do in the Lord and the living of everyday life?
11. What is your title? What describes your position in life? How can you take heed to fulfill it and what can you do to help others?
12. Pray that God sends us a soldier to do the work of Archippus here.
