Questions For Sunday's Night Discussion January 13th, 2019

- 1. (All) What is the biggest fish you have ever caught?
- 2. **(All)** Read Luke 5:1-11. If Peter and the other men had already been called disciples of Jesus, why were they fishing while Jesus was teaching?
- 3. **(Kids)** What does commitment mean? What kind of commitment toward Jesus should we have? What kind of commitment does he have to us?
- 4. **(All)** If you had been Peter when Jesus said, put out into the deep water and let down the nets for a catch what would you have said?
- 5. **(All)** Do we ever think we know more than Jesus about certain things? How does that happen?
- 6. (Kids) What do you think the fishermen though when they saw all those fish in the nets?
- 7. **(All)** Why do you think Peter said, "Depart from me, Lord; I am a sinful man? What sin did he commit?
