6. What if he saw someone who had died long ago? What does he (or really all of us) really need to "see" to be changed?
7. Hebrews 12:25 - See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven. Why do we sometimes question whether God really means what he says? Or if maybe he has changed his mind?
8. Daniel 12:2 - And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. Matthew 25:49 And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life. There are only two places we can go after we die. Does the world sometimes think there is a third option? Do we?
