7. What is hostile toward God about doing genuinely good works and making the world a better place, while doing them apart from faith in the word of truth?
8. What is different between doing good works while be reconciled to God vs while be unreconciled?
9. What can shake a person from continuing in faith?
10. Are doubts a sign of unstable, shaky faith that is shifting away from hope? Are some doubts acceptable and others not?
11. How is the gospel proclaimed to all creation? Why do all things need reconciliation?
12. How can you be a minister of reconciliation for all creation? Pray that God uses this church to that end.
